## APPLICATION

The Ronadero Company, Inc., by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for approval of the downhole commingling of Devonian and Pennsylvanian production, and in support thereof would show:

- 1. Applicant has drilled a well in Unit F of Section 23,
  Township 12 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New
  Mexico, at a location 1980 feet from the West line and 1,650 feet
  from the North line of the Section.
  - 2. The SEI/4NWI/4 of the Section is dedicated to the well.
- 3. The well has perforations in and is capable of producing from the Pennsylvanian formation and the Devonian formation.
- 4. Applicant seeks approval for the downhole commingling of production from the Devonian and Pennsylvanian formations.
- 5. Applicant will, in the future, seek administrative approval for dual completion of the well without a hearing, and intends to present evidence in support thereof at the hearing on this application.
