Comes now Robert N. Enfield through his attorneys and respectfully requests approval of an unorthodox gas well location, Eddy County, New Mexico and in support thereof states as follows:

1. Applicant is operator with interest of the underlying of the Section 18, Township 21 South, Range 23 East, NMPM, Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant wishes to drill an unorthodox gas well to test the Pennsylvanian formation underlying said Section 18 at a location 1,200 feet from the South line and 330 feet of the East line of said Section 18.


3. That a well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.
