> Mr. Nearburg, are you familiar with the Q application of Chama in this case?

3	Q Are you familiar with the subject ac-
4	reage?
5	A Yes.
	MR. CARR: Mr. Examiner, at
6	this time I would like to note that the way the case has
7	been advertised is for a well location 1200 feet from the
8	south line and 400 feet from the east line. I'm sorry, 1400
9	feet from the east line of Section 10.
10	The location has had to be
11	moved. The location for the well will be 1170 from the east
12	Line, 1640 feet from the south line.
13	We are moving the location to-
14	ward a standard location from that which was advertised. We
15	submit that the legal notice is adequate and we request that
	the application be amended to reflect the new well location.
16	MR. STOGNER: It is still unor-
17	thodox, is it not?
18	MR. CARR: It is still unortho-
19	cox. It is less so than advertised.
20	MR. STOGNER: Mr. Carr, at this
21	time it might be nice to bring up, in the docket we had ad-
22	vertised for an unorthodox Morrow gas well location; how-
23	ever, I noticed in the written ad, we we got the Morrow off of a phoned-in ad, but in the written ad you asked for

STOGNER: This will be re-15 advertised for the next available hearing but we'll go ahead 16 and take testimony on this today. 17 Mr. Nearburg, will you briefly state what Chama seeks with this application? 18 Chama seeks ar unorthodox Pennsylvanian 19 well location 1170 feet from the east line, 1640 feet from 20 the south line, Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 24 21 East, the east half of Section 10 to be dedicated to the 22 well. 23 Q Would you please refer to what has 24 marked for identification as Chama Exhibit Number One and 25 review this for the Examiner?

2	A Exhibit Number One is a land plat showing
3	Section 10, east half unit outlined in yellow and the red
4	dot indicates the location of the well.
-	Q Does this also indicate the owners of
5	offsetting acreage?
6	A Yes. The only offset ownership which is
7	not held by Chama is the Pennzoil acreage in Section 2.
8	Q Would you now refer to what has been
9	marked Chama Exhibit Number Two and review this for us?
10	A Exhibit Number Two is a topographic map
11	of the area. The dotten line on the right that's highlight-
12	ϵ d in yellow is the existing road. The yellow line moving
	west is the proposed road contributed by the BLM for the lo-
13	cation, and the red dot shows the approved BLM location.
14	Q So the unorthodox location is necessi-
15	tated by topographical conditions.
16	A Yes.
17	Q Toward whom are you moving this well lo-
18	cation?
19	A Toward our own acreage.
20	Q Would you refer to what has been marked
	for identification as Chama Exhibit Number Three?
21	A Yes. Exhibit Number Three is a letter
22	from Florida Exploration Company saying they have no objec-
23	tion to the proposed well.
24	Q And where does Florida own acreage in re-
25	gard to the proposed unorthodox location?

7 1 Α Florida has a farmout from Chama in the 2 north half of 11. They're drilling a well in the northeast 3 quarter. 4 MR.
