ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on September 19, 1984, and on October 17, 1984, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiners Michael E. Stogner and Gilbert P. Quintana, respectively.

NOW, on this 8th day of January, 1985, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Chama Petroleum Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location 1640 feet from the South line and 1170 feet from the East line of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, to test the Pennsylvanian formation, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) The E/2 of said Section 10 is to be dedicated to the well.

(4) A well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.

(5) No offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

(6) Approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable

share of the gas in the affected formation, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

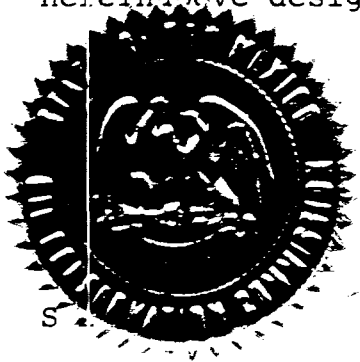
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The application of Chama Petroleum Company for an unorthodox gas well location for the Pennsylvanian formation is hereby approved for a well to be located at a point 1640 feet from the South line and 1170 feet from the East line of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(2) The E/2 of said Section 10 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.
