

A P P L I C A T I O N

COMES NOW, SUN EXPLORATION AND PRODUCTION COMPANY, by and through its attorneys, KELLAHIN & KELLAHIN, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for amendment of Order R-7677. Said Order approved an Unorthodox Oil Well location located 2,630 feet from North line and 1,610 feet from the East line of Section 27, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, to test the Montoya, Simpson and Granite Wash formations and the Crossroads Devonian Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Applicant now seeks to amend that Application, to change the location to an Unorthodox Well location located 2,561 feet from the South line and 1,610 feet from the East line of Section 27, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, to test the Montoya, Simpson and

Granite Wash formations and the Crossroads Devonian Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, would show:

1. Applicant has the right to drill and develop the NW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 27, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its U.D. Sawyer No. 11 Well in Unit J of said section, at an Unorthodox Oil Well location 2,561 feet from the South line, and 1,610 feet from the East line of Section 27, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, NMPM.

3. Applicant proposes to dedicate the NW/4 of the SE/4 to said well.

4. Applicant proposes to attempt a completion in the Montoya, Simpson and Granite Wash Formations, and the Crossroads Devonian Oil Pool.

5. Applicant proposes to simultaneously dedicate the NW/4 SE/4 to the subject well and to the U. D. Sawyer No. 7 well and seeks approval of the simultaneous dedication and permission to produce the 40-acre oil allowable assigned to this unit from either the No. 7 well or the No. 11 well or in any combination thereof.
