The Exhibit Two is a northeast-southwest cross section showing the two wells in the area of the Crossroads Field that were drilled through the Granite Wash, and we have projected the Montoya, the Simpson, and the Granite Wash from the Shell No. 2 Bluitt and the Ralph Lowe No. 1 TP State through the Crossroads Field. So we would—this was our target. The Granite Wash had never been drilled in the Crossroads area.

A It is.

Q Will the approval of your application for an unorthodox location permit Sun to produce hydrocarbons which would not otherwise be produced?

A Yes.

Q And will it--will granting of the application protect correlative rights, promote conservation, and prevent waste.

A Yes, it will.

Q With reference to the four exhibits we've talked about, were those prepared by you or prepared and submitted from your company records?

A Submitted from my company records.

MS. AUBREY: Mr. Examiner, I cffer Exhibits One through Four, and I have no further questions of the witness.

MR. STOGNER: Exhibits One through Four will be admitted into evidence.

Mr. McConnell, if we will look at Exhibit Number Four, which was dated August 7, 1984, it referred to the application for unorthodox well location. What was the location, the footage location, that was -- that they were referring to?

STOGNER: Do you still 13 wish to try for a completion in the Montoya, Simpson, and 14 Granite Wash formations or--and the Crossroads-Devonian oil 15 pool--or just for the Crossroads-Devonian oil pool? Α I would like to leave the option open to 16 complete in the Granite Wash although the geologists and en-17 gineers do not view it as a viable target. 18 MR. STOGNER: Mr. McConnell, do 19 you wish me to issue an order for all four formations or 20 just for the Granite Wash and Devonian? 21 Α I would like to have an order issued for 22 the--for the Granite Wash, the Simpson, Montoya, and Devon-23 ian. 24 MR. STOGNER: Thank you, sir.
