Gentlemen:

While you have presented evidence of crossflow in the wellbore of the Sam H. Snoddy Federal No. 1, I am not sure you have presented evidence for a hardship case.

The OCD considers the Morrow formation as one pool, but almost everyone who works with the Morrow considers each zone a separate reservoir which will deplete at different rates and crossflow would occur if the well is shut in. For this reason, at least one operator in Lea County completes wells by zones not formations, which is an option for the operator.

Because inderground waste may be occurring, I am approving a hardship well classification for 45 days and am recommending that you set this case for hearing luring this time period.
