ORDER ABOLISHING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN  
EXISTING POOLS IN RIO ARRIBA, SAN JUAN,  
AND SANDOVAL COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on April 10, 1985, and June 5, 1985, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Gilbert P. Quintana.

NOW, on this 12th day of June, 1985, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) There is need for the abolishment of the San Ysidro-Mancos Oil Pool in Sandoval County, New Mexico.

(3) There is need for certain extensions to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, the Counselors Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, the South Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, and the Lybrook-Gallup Oil Pool in Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, the Devils Fork-Mesaverde Oil Pool and the Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, the Dufers Point Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, and the Rio Puerco-Mancos Oil Pool in Sandoval County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(a) The San Ysidro-Mancos Oil Pool in Sandoval County, New Mexico, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 21 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, NMPM

Section 28: NW/4 NW/4

Section 29: N/2 NE/4 and W/2

Section 30: E/2 E/2 and SW/4 SE/4

is hereby abolished.

(b) The Blanco-Mesaverde Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, NMPM

Section 24: N/2

(c) The Counselors Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool in Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 23 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM

Section 23: W/2

Section 26: NW/4

(d) The Devils Fork-Mesaverde Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM

Section 7: NE/4 NW/4

(e) The Dufers Point Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST, NMPM

Section 8: SE/4

(f) The Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST, NMPM

Section 11: E/2

(g) The South Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool in Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 23 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, NMPM

(h) The West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool in Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, NMPM

(i) The Lybrook-Gallup Oil Pool in Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 23 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, NMPM

Section 26: NE/4 SE/4

(j) The Rio Puerco-Mancos Oil Pool in Sandoval County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 21 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, NMPM

Sections 28 through 30: All  
Sections 32 and 33: All

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

(1) Pursuant to Section 70-2-18, NMSA 1978, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well, which by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.

(2) The effective date of this order and all abolishments and extensions included herein shall be July 1, 1985.
