Would you state your full name and place

3	A Mitchell Elkins, Midland, Texas.		
4	Q Mr. Elkins, by whom are you employed?		
5	A Union Oil Company of California.		
6	Q Have you previously testified before this		
	Division or one of its examiners and had your credentials		
7	accepted and made a matter of record?		
8	A No, sir, I have not.		
9	Q Would you summarize your educational		
10	background for Mr. Stogner?		
11	A I attended one year at Angelo State Uni-		
12	versity. I received approximately 100 hours in chemical en-		
13	gineering from New Mexico State University and will receive		
14	a degree in petroleum engineering from the University of		
	Texas, Permian Basin, in May of this year.		
15	Q Would you review your work experience for		
16	Mr. Stogner?		
17	A I have held a variety of positions from		
18	laborer to construction foreman doing contract work for El		
19	Paso Natural Gas; worked two summers for Getty Oil Company		
20	as an engineering trainee, and have presently worked three		
21	and a half years for Union Oil Company of California as an		
22	engineering technician in Midland.		
23	Q And you've been in Midland the entire		
	three and a half years?		
24	A Yes, sir, I have.		
25	Q Are you familiar with the application		

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2	rules for the North Anderson Ranch Wolfcamp Pool?

13	A The proposed well is located in the
	northwest quarter of the governmental quarter section.
14	Q And what is the actual footage location
15	for that well?
16	A As I stated, 660 feet from the north
17	line, 1980 feet from the east line of Section 28.
18	Q And this puts it in the center of the
19	quarter quarter section.
20	A Yes, sir, it does.
21	Q Did you seek to obtain administrative ap-
22	proval for the unorthodox location of this well?
	A Yes, sir, we did, and we were informed by
23	Mr. Carpenter of the Hobbs District that the application was
24	being set for hearing.
25	Q And was that because of these special
