COMES NOW Yates Petroleum Corporation, by its attorneys, and in support hereof, respectfully states:

 Applicant is the operator of all zones underlying:

Township 19 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 29: S/2

containing 320 acres, more or less,

and proposes to drill its Amoco "QT" Federal No. 2 Well at a point located 660 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of said Section 29.

2. The Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements of Rule 104 of the Oil Conservation Division to permit the drilling of the well at the above mentioned unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test the Cisco Canyon formation. 3. A standard 320-acre gas proration unit in all zones from the top of the Wolfcamp formation to the base of the Cisco Canyon formation comprising the S/2 of said Section 29 should be dedicated to such well or to such lesser portion thereof as is reasonably shown to be productive of gas.

4. The approval of this application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of gas, will prevent economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays:

A. That this application be set for hearing before an examiner and that notice of said hearing be given as required by law.

B. That upon hearing the Division enter its order granting Applicant permission to drill its Amoco "QT" Federal No. 2 Well at a point 660 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of said Section 29, and to dedicate the S/2 of Section 29 to said well.

C. And for such other and further relief as may be just in the premises.
