


3. That the applicant proposes to inject saltwater through a 2 3/8" tubing installed in a packer set at approximately 3,345 feet.

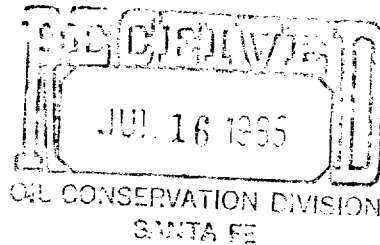


