Dear Mr. Stamets:

On August 14, and 28, 1985 the above-referenced application was heard before the Oil Conservation Division. On August 14, we presented the main portion of our case and on August 28, Apache Corporation and Union Texas Petroleum were given an opportunity to present rebuttal testimony to our main case. Apache and Union Texas on August 28, preferred not to submit any testimony. Our side presented a small amount of additional testimony and thereafter closing arguments were accepted by Mr. Stogner in the case. On or by August 28, both sides had also tendered their proposed Orders to Mr. Stogner for his consideration.

Following the August 14th hearing and the August 28th hearing, both sides asked Mr. Stogner for an expeditious Order for reasons pertinent to each side. Mr. Scott's reason for asking for an expeditious Order was that he is dealing with an expiring lease. In order to formulate drilling plans, Mr. Scott needs some lead time in order to be able to plan things in an orderly fashion.

While it is not my custom or practice to attempt to secure Orders from your division outside of their normal channels, I must request, in this instance, that you look into the reasons for delay in the issuance of an Order in this case. Without an Order, we are simply at a loss in trying to evaluate our legal and development options both from the standpoint of further administrative proceedings and current litigation which is pending between these parties and other parties in the district court in Lovington, New Mexico. Needless to say, my client has a substantial investment in the lands and leases involved in this case.

Finally, I would appreciate anything that you can do concerning the issuance of an Order in this case. On the other hand, if there is some additional information or assistance that I can supply, please do not hesitate to call on me. Thank you very much.
