A P P L I C A T I O N


Comes now RIO PECOS CORPORATION, by and through its attorneys, Kellahin & Kellahin, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order approving an unorthodox gas well location at a location 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 34, T16S, R34E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show:

1. Applicant has the right to drill and develop the N/2 of Section 34, T16S, R34E, NMPM.
2. Applicant proposes to drill a well to test the Morrow Formation at a location 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 34, T16S, R34E, NMPM.
3. Applicant proposes to dedicate a 320-acre tract consisting of the N/2 of said Section 34 to the well.
4. This application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, after notice and hearing, the applicant requests that this application be granted.
