Failure to plug these wells in a timely fashion could result in forfeiture of your bond.

You are hereby directed to prepare and forward to the District I office in Hobbs a Notice of Intent to Plug and Abandon (Form C-103) for each of the above wells within fifteen (15) days. Failure to do so will result in a hearing to show cause why the OCD should not plug these wells. If the OCD is required to undertake these pluggings, your bonds will be forfeited.
