
### PLUGGING PROCEDURE


Contractors will furnish tubing, mud, water and cement, and will construct pits as necessary. All plugs will be set through tubing.

- 1. Displace hole to mud -- all fluid to be displaced into pit and properly disposed of.
- 2. Set CIBP at  $2770^{\frac{1}{2}}$  and dimp 35' of cement over top of CIBP.
- 3. Set 100' plug inside of 8 5/8" casing at approximately 2100' (Top of Anhydrite)
- 4. Set 10 sack cap with regulation marker as prescribed by OCD Rules and Regulations.
- 5. Proper clean up will be made and all salvaged equipment will be moved to a place to be designated.
- 6. Return surface to as near normal conditions as possible.
- 7. All work will be supervised by an Oil Conservation Division Representative.
