social counseling," said Dr. Vernon Mark, the director of neurosurgery at Boston City Hospital, who was chairman of the symposium. But, he said, "Most (offenders) are not recognized as having something organically wrong with them."

Researchers in the rapidly developing field of biological psychiatry say it has often made the traditional psychoanalytic approach obsolete by tracing many serious mental illnesses to physiological brain abnormalities.

The researchers attending the symposium cited two examples where biological psychiatry could have headed off violence.

Months before John W. Hinckley tried to assassinate President Reagan in 1981, he complained to a psychologist about violent thoughts and about being obsessed with teen-age movie star Jodie Foster. But the doctor released him from care, saying Hinckley was not seriously mentally ill.

After Reagan and three others were shot, a scan revealed Hinckley suffered from cortical atrophy, a form of brain damage found in one of every three schizophrenics but in only 2 percent of the general population.

The condition can be controlled by a drug.

Charles Whitman, a sniper who killed 14 people and wounded 31 from a University of Texas tower in 1966, suffered from headaches and repeatedly asked to be committed to a doctor's care before the shooting spree, Mark said.

After he was slain by police, an autopsy revealed the cause of Whitman's violence — a tumor at the base of his brain.

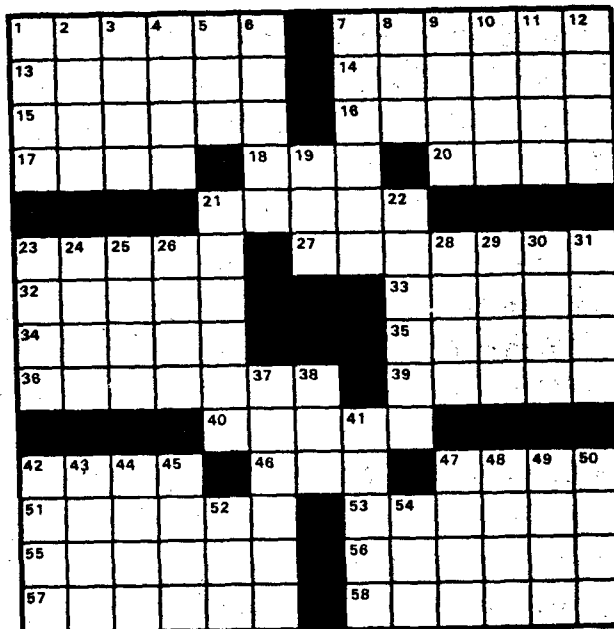


