18 BY MR. TAYLOR:

19 Q Would you please state your name, posi-
20 tion, and place of residence for the record?

21 A I'm Jami Bailey, Field Representative
22 with the Oil Conservation Division and I live in Santa Fe,
23 New Mexico.

24 Q And, Ms. Bailey, have you ever testified

4 Q Would you then for the Examiner state
5 your background and educational experience?

6 A In 1983 I graduated cum laude from Texas
7 Christian University in Ft. Worth, Texas, with a BS degree
8 in geology.

9 In 1982 to '84 I worked for Gramps Field,
10 a private oil field in southern Colorado. I was the Field
11 Geologist responsible for the exploration and development
12 program.

13 I'm still their consulting geologist.

14 From September, 1984, to April '85 I
15 worked for VeneKlasen Associates, a local private consul-
16 tant, where I was the geohydrologist.

17 In April of 1985 I joined the OCD Envi-
18 ronmental Bureau, where I am the Field Representative.

19 Among other duties I serve as a technical
20 consultant in geological matters for the bureau.

21 MR. TAYLOR: Mr. Examiner, I
22 tender the witness as a qualified expert.

23 MR. CATANACH: The witness is
24 considered qualified.

25 Q Ms. Bailey, are you prepared to make re-
commendations to the Examiner today concerning the nomencla-
