

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. February 5, 1986, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner David R. Catanach.

NOW, on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of February, 1985 the Division Director having considered the testimony, the record, the recommendations of the Examiner, and having fully advised in the premises.

#### FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jusisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.

(1) That pursuant to Section 70-2-18, NMSA 1978, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 9169, any well which by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger that the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proporation to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of the allowable.

(2) The effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included therein shall be March 1, 1986.
