The records of The Petroleum Corporation of Delaware indicate that Nu-Energy Oil & Gas, Inc. owns an undivided 2.5% oil and gas leasehold interest in the following described property:

#### APPLICATION

The Petroleum Corporation of Delaware, by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an Order pooling all interests underlying the SW4NW4 of Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico for all depths from 3,500 feet beneath the surface of the earth down to 5,600 feet beneath the surface of the earth, and in support thereof would show:

- 1. Applicant is entitled to proceed with the drilling of a well located in the SWANWA of Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, under the authority of Applicant's ownership of an oil and gas leasehold interest therein.
- 2. Applicant intends to drill its well at a legal location in said SW4NW4 Section 12, to a depth of 5,500 feet to test the Cherry Canyon Formation. Applicant has requested the party listed on the attached schedule as owner of an undivided interest to agree to participate in the drilling of said well or to farmout or otherwise commit their interest to said well, but the party so far has refused to do so.
- 3. Applicant seeks that the Division consider the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charge for supervision, designation of Applicant as operator of the well, and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.
- 4. The pooling of all interests in SW\\\ NW\\\\ Section 12, for all depths from 3,500 feet beneath the surface of the earth down to 5,600 feet beneath the surface of the earth, is in the interest of conservation and will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
- 5. Applicant respectfully requests the setting of this matter before an Examiner at the first available hearing.
