GEOLOGY:

The Tres Papolotes field located in T-14, R-34, Lea County, New Mexico, produces from several members of the Bough "C" formation. The Bough "C" is widely productive along the western platform margin of the Tatum Basin. Dated as Permo-Penn in age, the productive members consist of clean porous white limestone, very forsiliferous, with chert nodules interspersed within the limeston. The depositional model of this reservoir is that most likely algal mats grew and thrived within the photic zone, basinward from the basin edge in a relatively high energy enviroment, achieving in the process the porous high permeability productive limestone.
