3 The New Mexico Oil Conservation
4 Division by Division Order No. R-8124, dated January 16th,
5 1986, issued in Case 8745, authorized the applicant to con-
6 duct a long-term reservoir pressure test in the Mancos for-
7 mation using certain wells in Rio Arriba County, and further
8 authorized the shut-in of certain wells and provided six
9 months after completion of the test during which certain ac-
10 cumulated underproduction can be made up.

11 Applicant in the above styled
12 case now seeks the amendment of said Order No. R-8124 to
13 provide for twelve months after completion of the reservoir
14 pressure test, during which to make up the accumulated un-
15 derproduction of certain wells resulting from the test.

16 Applicant further requests that
17 all other provisions of said Order No. R-8124 remain in full
18 force and effect.

19 This case will be continued to
20 September 24th Commission Hearing.

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22 And Case 9111, which was con-
23 tinued from June 18th, application of Benson-Montin-Greer
24 Drilling Corporation for the expansion of the BMG West Puer-
