NOW, on this 13th day of April, 1987, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

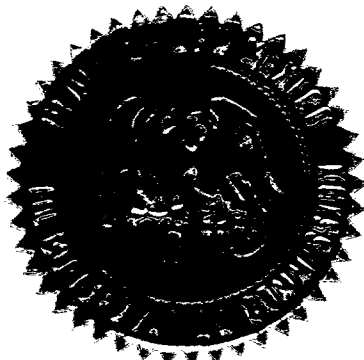
FINDS THAT:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


Case No. 9108 is hereby dismissed.
