APPLICATION

Long Trusts hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox oil well location in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, Township 6 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant has the right to drill a well in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, Township 6 South, Range 33 East, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant seeks approval to drill its Lambirth B No. 3 Well at an unorthodox location 900 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of said Section 3, to be completed in the South Peterson-Fusselman Pool.

3. The N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 3 is to be dedicated to the unit.

4. Approval of this application will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

5. Applicant requests that this matter be heard at the April 8, 1987 Examiner hearing.
