APPLICATION

Comes now ANDARDKO PETROLEUM CORPORATION, by and through its attorneys, Kellahin, Kellahin & Aubrey, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order amending the Special Rules and Regulations for the Foster-San Andres Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to increase the Gas oil ratio limitation from the current 5,000 cubic feet of gas to one barrel of oil to a new limit of 10,000 cubic feet of gas to one barrel of oil effective September 1, 1986, and in support there would show:

- (1) Applicant is the operator of the Harvard No. 1 well located in Unit O, Section 31, T18S, R39E, Foster-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (2) That the other operators in the San Andres Pool are Texas American and Martindale Petroleum Company.
- (3) That attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a list of the names and addresses of all interested parties to whom applicant has sent notice of the hearing of this

application in accordance with the requirements of Rule 1207 (Order R-8054).

- (4) The Foster-San Andres Pool is a solution gas drive reservoir established by the Division in Order R-1059 entered on January 1, 1950.
- (5) By Order R-8113 issued January 6, 1986 the Division established a limiting gas-oil ratio of 5000 cubic feet of gas for each barrel of oil for the Foster-San Andres Pool.
- (6) That at the current stage of pool development, wells in the pool can be operated at a limiting gas oil ratio of 10,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil without waste.
- (7) Based upon available engineering data, the proposed limiting gas oil ratio can be made effective as of September 1, 1986 without violation of the correlative rights of any operator.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing and that after notice and hearing the application be granted as requested.
