APPLICATION OF ELF AQUITAINE PETROLEUM, A DIVISION OF ELF AQUITAINE, INC., FOR THE DRILLING OF A HORIZONTAL WELL AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR HORIZONTALLY DRILLED WELLS WITHIN A PORTION OF THE WEST LINDRITH GALLUP OIL POOL, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

APPLICATION

Elf Aquitaine Petroleum, a division of Elf Aquitaine, Inc., hereby applies for approval of a horizontal directionally drilled well and for special provisions relating to such wells within a portion of the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the W 1/2 of Section 14, Township 23 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

2. The W 1/2 of Section 14 is located within the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool.

3. The special rules and regulations of the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool provide for 160 acres oil well spacing, and further provide that said pool is governed by the general rules and regulations for the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool promulgated by Order No. 4314.

4. The Chacon Jicarilla Apache D No. 2 Well is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14 and has the NW 1/4 of Section 14 dedicated to it. Said well is currently near depletion. 5. The Chacon Jicarilla Apache No. 6 Well is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14 and has the SW 1/4 of Section 14 dedicated to it. Said well is currently shut-in.

6. Applicant seeks approval to drill the Jicarilla Thomas Apache H No. 1 Well from a surface location 500 feet FNL and 1,500 feet FWL, Section 14, Township 23 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, and directionally drill horizontally through the Dakota formation, in a southeasterly direction. The producing interval in the horizontal portion of the well bore will be located in both the NW 1/4 and SW 1/4 of Section 14.

7. Applicant seeks special provisions for the W 1/2 of Section 14, within the Chacon-Dakota Associated Pool, for horizontal directionally drilled wells, including:

- A. Permission to dedicate two 160 acre units to one well. In particular, the NW 1/4 and SW 1/4 of Section 14 will be dedicated to the Chacon Jicarilla Apache H No. 1 Well.
- B. Relief from the orthodox well location requirements or Order No. R-4314. Specifically, applicant requests that a horizontal directionally drilled well not be considered unorthodox so long as the well perforations are no closer than 660 feet from the outer boundary of the W 1/2 of Section 14.
- C. An oil well allowable based upon two 160 acre units.

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8. The matters requested herein by applicant are in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
