NOW, on this 25th day of June, 1987, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

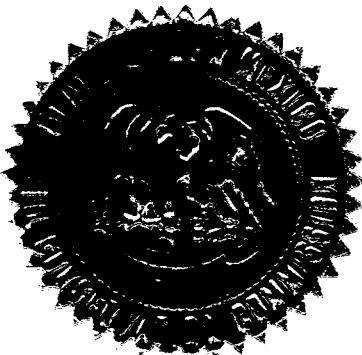
FINDS THAT:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


Case No. 9155 is hereby dismissed.
