COMES NOW, Dugan Production Corp., by and through its attorney, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of a Non-Standard Proration Unit of 160 acres, consisting of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section 25, Township 21 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Sandoval County, New Mexico, for its Husky Federal #2 well located in Unit D of said section. As grounds therefore, Applicant states:

- 1. The Husky Federal #2 well was completed on December 8, 1983 in an Undesignated Gallup formation on 40 acre spacing with an initial potential of 28 barrels of oil and gas too small to measure.
- 2. Effective April 1, 1984, the Rio Puerco-Mancos Pool was established by Order R-7471 creating temporary pool rules providing for 320 acre spacing, and said Order was made permanent by Order R-7471-B on June 2, 1986.
- 3. By nomenclature, said Pool was extended to include acreage subject to this Application.
- 4. The initial potential and production history of the Husky Federal #2 well indicates that the well is not capable of and will not drain 320 acres.






