DEAR INTEREST OWNER:

MERIDIAN OIL PLANS TO INSTALL A CENTRAL POINT METERING AND LATERAL COMPRESSION SYSTEM ON THOSE WELLS SUBJECT TO THE PICTURED CLIFFS PARTICIPATING AREA IN THE REFERENCED UNIT. ANY NON-PARTICIPATING AREA WELL OR WELLS COMMUNITIZED WITH NON-UNIT ACREAGE WILL CON-TINUE TO HAVE THEIR OWN METER.

CENTRAL POINT METERING WILL ALLOW MERIDIAN, AS OPERATOR, TO MORE EFFICIENTLY PRODUCE THESE WELLS AND THE INSTALLATION OF LATERAL COMPRESSION SHOULD INCREASE THE GAS PRODUCTION FROM THE AFFECTED WELLS. THE COMBINATION OF THE TWO SHOULD INCREASE GAS PRODUCTION BY A SUBSTANTIAL AMOUNT.

THIS PROJECT WILL NOT CHANGE YOUR INTEREST AS AN INTEREST OWNER OTHER THAN POSSIBLY INCREASING GAS PRODUCTION.
