

Pursuant to our telephone conversation, enclosed is a copy of the application we proposed before the Oil Conservation Division on August 3, 1988 pertinent to the captioned well.

We drilled the Laguna Colorado #2-6 in the SE/4NW/4 of Section ~~2~~<sup>2</sup> T23N-R1W as a Dakota well, which proved to be non-commercial. We elected to come uphole and perforate the Gallup formation.

Inasmuch as Section 2 is unspaced as to the Gallup formation, we requested that the Oil Conservation Division expand the West Puerto Chiquito pool, which is spaced on 640 acres for the Gallup formation, one mile to the south to include Section 2.

Inadvertently, we failed to notify Southern Union Exploration of the hearing. It is my understanding that Southern Union owns the S/2N/2, S/2 of Section 36-T24N-R1W, which lies within one mile of our well.
