We received the subject application on July 15, 1988. At the request of the Aztec District Office, this filing was set for hearing without being reviewed. Last week the Aztec office reconsidered and requested it be handled administratively. In reviewing I found that the location is approximately 570 feet from the eastern boundary of the proposed proration unit, making it an unorthodox gas well location pursuant to General Rule 104 C.II(B). Please submit an amended filing to cover this portion of the application.
