APPLICATION

COMES NOW Oryx Energy Company, formerly Sun Exploration and Production Company, by and through it attorneys, Kellahin, Kellahin & Aubrey and in accordance with Section 70-2-17(c) NMSA-1978 applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order pooling all mineral interest effective July 12, 1989 in the Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool underlying a 640 acre spacing and proration unit being all of Section 12, T25N, R2W, NMPM, to be dedicated to Mallon Oil Company's Johnson Federal No. 12-5 Well, located in the SW/4NW/4 (Unit E) of said Section 12, and in support thereof would show:

- Applicant is a working interest owner in the NE/4 of Section 12, T25N, R2W, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
- The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission issued Order R-7407-E effective June 8, 1987 which provides for a

640 acre spacing and proration unit for the Gavilan-Mancos
Oil Pool.

- 3. On October 24, 1985 Mallon Oil Company completed its Johnson Federal No. 12-5 Well located in the SW/4NW/4 of said Section 12 for production from the Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool to which the W/2 of Section 12 is dedicated.
- 4. In compliance with Division Order R-7407-E and in accordance with Section 70-2-17(c) NMSA-1978, Applicant has sought the voluntary agreement of all appropriate interest owners in Section 12 for the dedication of all of Section 12 to the Mallon Johnson Federal No. 12-5 Well.
- 5. Although Applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the Mallon Johnson Federal No. 12-5 Well and to share in production from said well in compliance with Order R-7407-E, certain interest owners have either refused or have failed to join in dedicating their interest on a voluntary basis.
- 6. In the event Applicant is unable to obtain a compulsory pooling order pooling all of Section 12, the Applicant's leasehold interest in the NE/4 of said section will expire on July 31, 1989.
- 7. Applicant requests that the effective date of the pooling order be the date of the hearing of July 12, 1989.
- 8. The pooling of all interests underlying Section 12 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

9. In accordance with Division notice rules, the Applicant has provided a copy of this application and notice to all parties listed on Exhibit A, B and C hereto.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before the duly appointed Division examiner on July 12, 1989 and that after hearing the Division enter its order pooling the mineral interest described herein.

Applicant further seeks that Mallon Oil Company be named operator of the well, that the order provide for a fair and equitable means for participation in the costs and production from the well, and that the effective date of the allocation of production be July 12, 1989, and that if after the election period expires, any party who has failed to pay its fair share of the participation costs be assessed a risk factor and for such other and further relief as may be proper.
