

Commission Hearing - Thursday - September 21, 1989

CASE 9670: (De Novo) Continued and Readvertised.)

Application of Stevens Operating Corporation to amend Division Order No. R-8917, directional drilling and an unorthodox oil well location, Chaves County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks to amend Division Order No. R-8917 to allow for re-entry of the currently plugged and abandoned Philtex Honolulu Federal Well No. 1 located 1930 feet from the South and West lines (Unit A) of Section 9, Township 14 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, North King Camp-Devonian Pool, in lieu of drilling a new well at the unorthodox location approved by said Order. Applicant further seeks approval to directionally drill said Philtex Honolulu Federal Well No. 1 to a depth of approximately 9894 feet, and to bottom said well at an unorthodox bottomhole location at a point 1947 feet from the South line and 2562 feet from the West line of said Section 9. A 160-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the E/2 W/2 of said Section 9. (Approved by Order No. R-8917) is to be dedicated to the above described well. Said location is approximately 17 miles east of Hagerman, New Mexico. Upon application of Santa Fe Exploration Company, this case will be heard De Novo pursuant to the provisions of Rule 1220.

CASE 9697: (Continued from August 17, 1989, Commission Hearing.)

Application of Santa Fe Exploration Company for amendment of the special rules and regulations for the North King Camp-Devonian Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks to amend Rule 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the North King Camp-Devonian Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8806 by establishing a special depth bracket allowable of 350 barrels of oil per day for the pool (pursuant to General Rules 505[d]). Said pool presently comprises the SE/4 of Section 9, Township 14 South, Range 29 East and is located approximately 17 miles east of Hagerman, New Mexico.
