Application of Marathon Oil Company for an addendum to Division Order No. R-9050-A, to include provision for dual completion and an unorthodox gas well location in the undesignated Indian Basin-Morrow Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. Application of Sunco Trucking Water Disposal for a permit to construct and operate a commercial wastewater evaporation pond, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks authorization, pursuant to Division General Rule 711, to construct a synthetically double lined wastewater evaporation pool equipped with proper leak detection for the purpose of commercially disposing of nonhazardous wastewater associated with the completion and production operations of oil and gas wells.
