
COUNTY LEA POOL SOUTH TONTO-BONE SPRING





## IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

- (1) That pursuant to Section 70-2-18, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which by virtue of any of the pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division shall subject the well to cancellation of the allowable.
- (2) The effective date of this order and all extensions shall be June 1, 1990.
