

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


Re: Application of Stevens & Tull, Inc. for Downhole Commingling, Lea County,

Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Stevens & Tull, Inc. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking blanket authority to downhole commingle production from the Abo, Drinkard, Tubb and Blinebry formations under the N/2 SE/4 of Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Stevens & Tull, Inc. proposes downhole commingling of production from the Abo formation D-K-Abo Pool, the Drinkard formation, D-K-Drinkard Pool, the Tubb Formation, Warren Tubb Pool, and the Blinebry formation, Blinebry Oil & Gas Pool, in the wellbore of any well located on said acreage.

This application has been set for hearing before a Oil Conservation Division Examiner on June 13, 1990. You are not required to attend this hearing but as an offsetting operator, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record in this case will preclude you from challenging this matter at a later date.
