(4) The applicant also requests that this production may be stored off-lease and surface commingled at any of the current existing facilities or any future developed facilities on the above identified leases.

(5) The applicant further requests that the current groupings of wells and leases with existing facilities may be realigned as needed in the future to maintain the most cost effective and recovery efficient operations for these leases and facilities.

(6) Further testimony indicates that the proposed commingling will result in substantial savings of capital outlay and operating costs which will extend the economic life of the subject wells, thus allowing additional oil recovery and thereby preventing waste.

(7) The applicant has notified each interest owner in the subject leases of its proposal including the United States Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico.

(8) No interest owner appeared at the hearing in opposition to the application.

(9) Subsequent to the hearing, the Division was informed that both the BLM and the Commissioner of Public Lands have tentatively approved the proposed commingling.

(10) In order to correctly allocate production to each lease and well, the applicant proposes to separately meter the production from each lease or individual well, where participation interest may vary within the same lease, prior to commingling.

(11) Approval of the proposed application is in the best interest of conservation, prevention of waste and protection of correlative rights.

(12) The proposed installation should be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

(13) Division Administrative Order Nos. CTB-332, CTB-338 and CTB-346 should be superseded by this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The applicant, Conoco Inc., is hereby authorized to surface commingle and store off-lease all North Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool production from existing wells and subsequently drilled wells on the following leases:

Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM

Lodewick "A" Lease:	NM/4 Section 19
Lehman Federal Lease:	SW/4 Section 18
Barbara Federal Lease:	S/2 Section 17, E/2 and NW/4, Section 18
Jenny Com Lease:	NW/4 Section 17
Julie Com Lease:	NE/4 Section 17
Dagger Draw Federal Lease:	NW/4 and E/2, Section 30
Dagger Draw Fee Lease:	SW/4 Section 19

Township 19 South, Range 24 East, NMPM

Dee State Lease (K-6385): SE/4 Section 36

Dee State Lease (LG-1525): SW/4 Section 36

(2) This production may be stored off-lease and surface commingled at any of the current existing facilities or any future developed facilities on the above identified leases.

(3) The current groupings of wells and leases with existing facilities from surface commingling and off-lease storage may be realigned as needed in the future to maintain the most cost effective and recovery efficient operations for these leases and facilities.

(4) In order to correctly allocate production to each lease, the applicant shall separately meter the production from each lease or from each well, where participation interests may vary within the same lease, prior to commingling.

(5) The installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

(6) Division Administrative Orders Nos. CTB-332, CTB-338 and CTB-346 are hereby superseded by this order.

(7) Jurisdiction is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary."

The first four pages attached to this letter is a copy of the approval by the Commissioner of Public Lands for Off-Lease Storage of Cisco Canyon Production from Lease K-6385 (Dee State No. 1) on Lease LG-1525 (Dee State No. 2) for your files.

The last two attached pages are two of the exhibits from our recent OCD hearing which identify the various commingling orders and storage facilities for Conoco operations in the North Dagger Draw Pool. The Dee State leases are the only state leases operated by Conoco in this pool. As EXHIBIT 3 illustrates, the Dee State Facility is somewhat isolated from the rest of our facilities and is expected to remain a separate entity from the rest of our operations.

FINDS THAT:

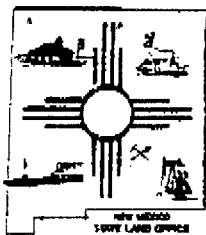
(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) By Division Administrative Order Nos. CTB-332, CTB-338 and CTB-346, Conoco Inc. was authorized to surface commingle North Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool production from various State, Federal and Fee leases in Township 19 South, Ranges 24 and 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) Due to an active drilling program currently underway in the North Dagger Draw Pool, continued and frequent administrative amendments to the existing commingling and off-lease storage orders are anticipated. 
