

Application of Union Oil Company of California

Hearing Date: April 16, 1992

Gentlemen:

Kaiser-Francis Oil Company has discussed this case with Unocal's representative in Midland, Mr. Jim Rose, and their attorney, Mr. William F. Carr. Both of these parties have assured me that Unocal's application should be restricted to Section 36 and 33, Township 25 South, Range 33 East and Sections 4 and 5, Township 26 South, Range 33 East of Lea County, New Mexico. Unocal indicates that Section 31, Township 25 South, Range 33 East and Section 6, Township 26 South 33 East were included in this application through an inadvertent error. Unocal has agreed to exclude both Section 31 and 6 from any order that the New Mexico OCD may decide to issue concerning Unocal's application.

Kaiser-Francis does not wish to protest Unocal's application for 640 acre spacing for the Pennsylvania Gas Pool within their Red Hills Unit as described previously. It is Kaiser-Francis' opinion that there is no evidence that conditions or parameters existing at Unocal's wells, drilled within this four section unit, exist outside of this unit. Therefore, it is our strong recommendation to the New Mexico OCD that any order granting Unocal's application be expressly limited to Sections 32, 33, 4 and 5.

Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated. Please advise if Kaiser-Francis is required to make an appearance in this case concerning the matter described herein.
