Dear Mr. Catanach:

At the June 25, 1992 hearing in the above-referenced case you asked Unocal's witness if there were other Atoka sand pools in the general area of the Red Hills-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool which were developed on 640-acre spacing. Unocal stated that they believed the Pitchfork Ranch-Atoka Pool was developed on this spacing pattern.

Following the hearing, Unocal has confirmed that the Pitchfork Ranch-Atoka Gas Pool is developed on 320-acre spacing. Attached for your information is data on the wells in this pool which shows that the Pitchfork "34" Federal No. 1 Well, the first well in the pool, recovered almost half the estimated ultimate recovery from this reservoir and that subsequent wells have produced substantially less.

Furthermore, when the distance between the PF "34" Federal No. 1 Well and offsetting wells is reviewed in conjunction with the data on the acres drained by each, it shows that wells in this Atoka sand can drain 640-acres.

We believe that this information demonstrates that these Atoka sand reservoirs can be drained effectively and efficiently by a limited number of wells. Although the Pitchfork Ranch Atoka-Gas Pool is not developed on 640-acre spacing units as we previously reported, we believe the data on this reservoir supports Unocal's request for permanent 640-acre spacing rules for its proposed Red Hills-Atoka Gas Pool.
