

WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:03 a.m.: CHAIRMAN LEMAY: The meeting will now come to 3 order. 4 This is the Oil Conservation Commission. 5 My name is Bill LeMay, I'm Chairman of the Oil Conservation 6 Commission. To my left is Commissioner Bill Weiss; to my 8 right, Commissioner Jami Bailey representing the 9 Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico. 10 We shall now call the first case on the docket, 11 which is Case 10,907, which is called by the Oil 12 Conservation Division to Amend Rules 1111, 1112 and 1115 of 13 14 the General Rules and Regulations, providing for the filing of Forms C-111, C-112 and C-115, respectively, on the last 15 business day of the month following the month of 16 production, and for the imposition of penalties for failure 17 to file timely and accurately. 18 Appearances in Case 10,907? 19 MR.
