WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:08 a.m.: CHAIRMAN LEMAY: We shall now call Case 10,907, 3 which is the matter called by the Oil Conservation Division 4 to amend Rules 1111, 1112 and 1115 of the General Rules and 5 Regulations. 6 Appearances in Case 10,907? 7 MR. CARROLL: May it please the Commission, my 8 9 name is Rand Carroll, appearing on behalf of the Oil 10 Conservation Division. I have no witnesses. CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Thank you. 11 Mr. Carroll, would you want to explain to the 12 fellow Commissioners what 10,907 actually does? I know 13 there's a prepared order, I think, on this case? 14 MR. CARROLL: Yes, I have exhibits. Actually, 15 it's three documents, and I've just put them all in one 16 exhibit --17 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Okay. 18 MR. CARROLL: -- OCD Exhibit Number 1. 19 May it please the Commission, this case is the 20 result of an interim order that was issued on February 21 17th, 1994, at which time the Commission decided, due to 22 23 the ONGARD system implementation, that three reports should 24 be filed on a temporary basis on the second month following

production or transportation or storage, rather than the

15th of the succeeding month. So we gave industry an extra month in order to file reports.

For instance, in February, if there's gas produced, stored or transported, they wouldn't have to report that gas until the 15th day of April. The prior rule would have required it on the 15th day of March.

Since that order was issued -- and that order has been extended a number of times, over two and a half years at this point -- a case was docketed to amend Rule 1115, which is the requirement of filing production reports by operators. That case was heard in August of this year, and an order was issued in October. That adopted on a permanent basis that temporary rule where the filing date was the 15th day of the second month following production.

Also in that order, electronic filing was required for C-115s and penalties were allowed to be imposed, also pursuant to that rule.

This is really a cleanup to make the temporary rule regarding the later filing also applicable to Rules 1111, and 1112. 1111 is the gas transporter's report and 1112 is the transporter's and storer's report.

I've taken the liberty of drafting a draft order for the Commission, and that is the first document contained in your Exhibit Number 1, and what I just outlined is contained on the first page here. The

paragraph under "By the Commission" refers to the interim order, and then Finding 2 down here refers to the rule amending -- or the order amending Rule 1115.

The third finding relates what we're asking for today, is to make the filing dates for the C-111s and -112s the same day as for C-115s.

And the last page of that first document is the exhibit which would be the new rules for both 1111 and 1112. And if you would refer to the third document of your exhibit, that document shows the changes that are made to current Rules 1111 and 1112 to make the filing date the second month rather than the first month.

And I've also included as the second exhibit the order amending Rule 1115.

So it is really cleanup, and we've discussed it in the Division, and the Division is not requesting that electronic filing be required for Rules 1111 and 1112 at this time. What was most important was Rule 1115, that the production reports be filed electronically, and the Division doesn't want to get into the fight at this time. If it's required in the future, we'll revisit these rules.

And we're also not asking that any penalty provisions be included in these rules. The amendments strictly relate to delaying the filing one month from the 15th day of the succeeding month to the 15th day of the

1	second succeeding month.
2	We've heard of no objection to this amendment,
3	and as you can see, nobody showed up to object either.
4	So we would request that these rules be amended
5	as shown in Exhibit A to the first document in Exhibit 1.
6	That's all I have.
7	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Any questions?
8	Commissioner Bailey, do you have any questions?
9	COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I have no questions.
10	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Commissioner Weiss?
11	COMMISSIONER WEISS: I have just a general
12	question.
13	How is that electronic filing proceeding now? Do
14	you have any comments? I've not heard anything about it in
15	a while.
16	MR. CARROLL: No, I'm not the person that would
17	have knowledge of that. Ed Martin would be the person to
18	ask.
19	COMMISSIONER WEISS: Yeah, just thought you might
20	be. Thank you.
21	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: And I have none.
22	Thank you, Mr. Carroll.
23	Is there anything else in Case Number 10,907?
24	MR. CARROLL: That's all I have.
25	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Before I close the case, you

1	have draft orders, you say, for us to sign?
2	MR. CARROLL: The draft order I've given to Sally
3	Martinez, and the draft order is the first document in your
4	Exhibit Number 1. So you can review it, and if it meets
5	with your approval Sally could finalize it and it could be
6	signed immediately.
7	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Could we sign it today, I'm
8	wondering, because she advertised it here.
9	MR. CARROLL: Right.
10	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Well, is it your intention to
11	take final action on this order today, Commissioner Weiss?
12	COMMISSIONER WEISS: Yes.
13	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Commissioner Bailey?
14	COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes.
15	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Thank you. And so I I
16	likewise.
17	So let the record show that final action will be
18	taken on Case Number 10,907 today. Therefore the case will
19	be closed.
20	Thank you.
