This letter is to advise you that Strata Production Company has filed the enclosed Application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking Special Pool Rules. including a gas-oil ratio of 10,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil produced, for the Nash Draw Brushy Canyon Delaware Pool. The Nash Draw Brushy Canyon Delaware Pool was last extended by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Order No. 10042, dated January 1, 1994, and now includes the following described acreage:

APPLICATION

COMES NOW STRATA PRODUCTION COMPANY ("Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for promulgation of Special Pool Rules and Regulations for the Nash Draw Brushy Canyon Delaware Pool, including a gas oil ratio of 10,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil produced and in support thereof states:

- 1. Applicant is the operator of all wells in the Nash Draw Brushy Canyon Delaware Pool.
- 2. The Nash Draw Brushy Canyon Delaware Pool was created by Oil Conservation Division Order No. 10042, dated January 1, 1994, and now includes the following described acreage:

Township 23 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M.:

Section 12: S/2

Section 13: E/2

Township 23 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M.:

Section 18: NW/4

3. The wells in the pool are produced under statewide rules that limit production to 142 barrels of oil per day and a gas oil ratio of 2,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil produced.

4. The Applicant seeks the promulgation of special pool rules and regulations for this pool which will increase the limiting gas oil ratio to 10,000 cubic feet of gas per

barrel of oil produced.

5. Approval of this Application will result in the production of hydrocarbons which otherwise will not be produced, will protect the correlative rights that will be in

the best interest of conversation.

WHEREFORE, Strata Production Company requests that this application be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 17, 1994 and that, after notice and hearing as required by law and the rules of the Division, the Division enter its Order promulgating Special Pool Rules and Regulations for the Nash Draw Brushy Canyon Delaware Pool including provisions for special Gas/Oil Ratio of 10,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil produced.
