1. Applicant operates the Lambirth No. 3 Well located 1980 feet from the North and East lines of Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant seeks an exception to the provisions of Division Rule 303-A to permit downhole commingling of production from the Fusselman formation, Peterson-Fusselman Pool, and the Pennsylvanian formation, South Peterson Pool, in the wellbore of said Lambirth No. 3.

3. Granting this application will result in the increased recovery of hydrocarbons and will not damage the subject reservoirs.

4. Granting this application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
