## Division Approved Plugging Program

Down Hole Equipment 8 5/8" at 110' with 100 sacks 4 1/2" at 3848' with 100 sacks 2 3/8" at unknown depth

- 1. Pull and check tubing.
- 2. Run Tubing to TD
- 3. Set a cement plug 3834'-3600' to cover Pictured Cliffs and Fruitland.
- 4. Come out of hole with tubing.
- 5. Find casing free point.
- 6. Shoot off and pull casing or perforate at free point.
- 7. Set a 100' cement plug at casing stub 50' inside and 50' outside or set a 100' plug inside and outside casing to isolate Ojo Alamo.
- 8. Set a cement plug 160'-60' below and inside surface pipe.
- 9. Set top plug and dry hole marker with a minimum of 10 sacks of cement.
- 10. Fill pits, clean and level location.

All plugs will be with Class A, B, or C cement with or without an accelerator.
