Amoco Production Company hereby makes application for an Order authorizing commingling Mesaverde, Gallup, and Dakota production within the wellbore of its Fred Phillips "C" No. 3, NW/4 15-25N-3W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and all wells subsequently to be drilled on these leases which include 960 acres in Sec. 10 and N/2 Sec. 15-25N-3W.

Amoco Production Company is the owner of all Mesaverde, Gallup, and Dakota working interest rights under these leases and royalty is common. These zones are, or are expected to be capable of low rates of production. The proposed commingling may result in the recovery of additional hydrocarbons from each of these formations, thereby preventing waste, and will not violate correlative rights.

In order to allocate the commingled production to each of the zones in the wells, we ask that the order allow Amoco to consult with the supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the Division to determine an allocation formula for any well downhole commingled under that order. We respectfully request this matter be set for hearing at the earliest possible date.




