Gentlemen:

We respectfully request an exception to Statewide Rule No. 104 (C)(1) for, and administrative approval under Statewide Rule 104 (F)(I,III) of the unorthodox location of the Keely-A Fed No. 29 - 1300 feet from North and 1500 feet from East lines, Unit B, Section 24, T-17-S, R-29-E, Eddy County. This well is a proposed Grayburg-Jackson (SR-Q-GB-SA) Pool oil completion with a projected total depth of 3200 feet. Form C-102 is attached.

The Keely-A Fed lease is a Federal lease. The proposed unorthodox location is necessary to permit the completion of an efficient production and injection pattern within a cooperative secondary recovery project. All surrounding proration units are operated by Phillips Oil Company.

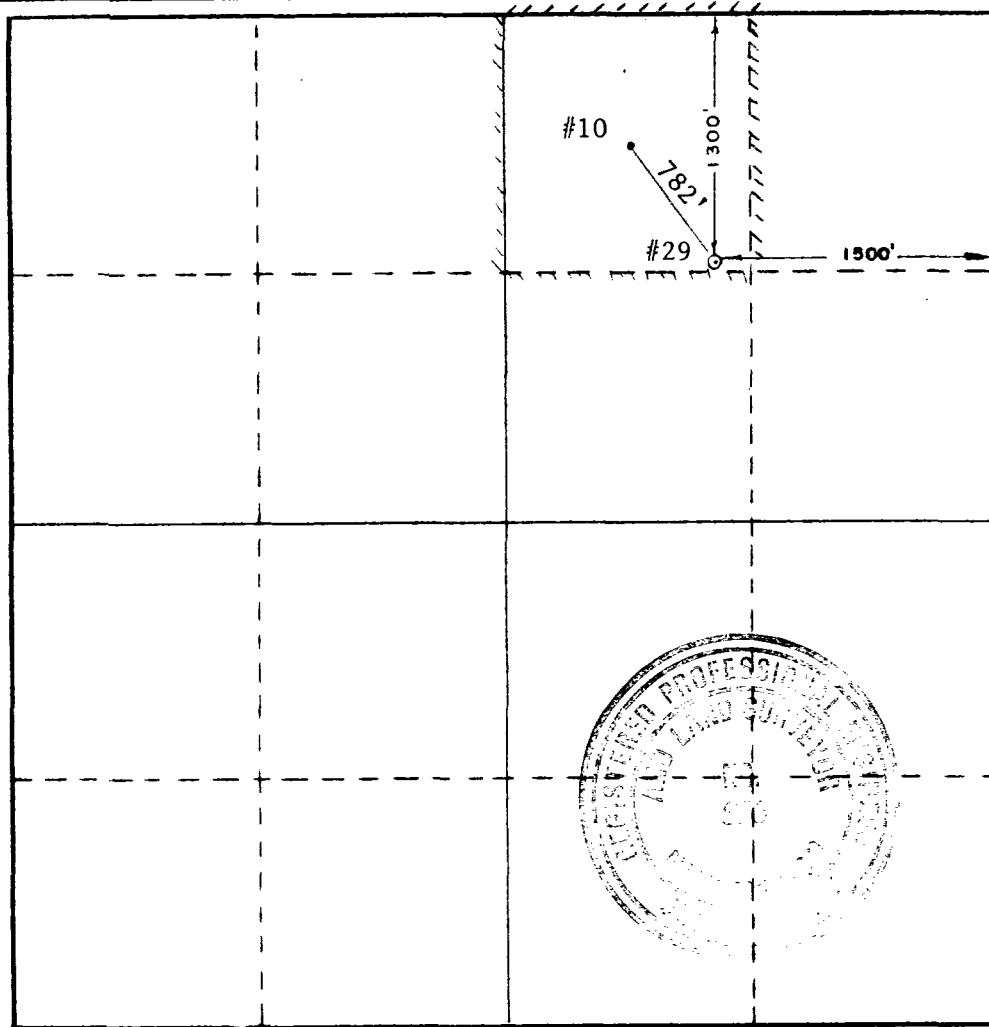
