A P P L I C A T I O N

COMES NOW, SAMSON RESOURCES COMPANY, and applies to the Oil Conservation Division of the State of New Mexico, for an Order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to 9,750 feet underlying the NW/4 of Section 8, Township 9 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, for the formation of a proration and spacing unit and an Order approving an unorthodox gas well location, and in support thereof would show the Commission:

1. Applicant is the owner of the right to drill and develop the NW/4 of Section 8, Township 9 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.

2. Applicant proposes to drill a well at an unorthodox location 525 feet from the West line and 600 feet from the North line, and proposes to dedicate the NW/4 of Section 8 to said well.

3. Applicant has selected the unorthodox location because of the location of a pipeline on the surface.

4. Applicant has sought to obtain the cooperation of all parties.

5. In order to obtain their just and equitable share of the production underlying the above lands, Applicant needs an Order pooling the mineral interest involved.





5. In order to obtain their just and equitable share of the production underlying the above lands, Applicant needs an Order pooling the mineral interest involved.

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
