IN THE MATTER OF THE HEARING CALLED BY THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING:

CASE NO. 9055 Order No. R-8375

APPLICATION OF NEARBURG PRODUCING COMPANY FOR AN UNORTHODOX OIL WELL LOCATION, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on December 17, 1986, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner David R. Catanach.

NOW, on this <u>23rd</u> day of December, 1986, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Nearburg Producing Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location 1665 feet from the North line and 830 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, to test the Strawn formation, Undesignated South Humble City-Strawn Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) The E/2 NE/4 of said Section 12 is to be dedicated to the well.

(4) Geophysical evidence presented by the applicant at the hearing indicated that a well at said unorthodox location would better enable the applicant to encounter the Strawn formation within the wellbore of the proposed well at a structurally advantageous position. -2-Case No. 9055 Order No. R-8375

(5) The applicant has successfully utilized geophysical data previously in this area in the drilling of a commercial Strawn oil well.

(6) No offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

(7) Approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil in the affected pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The application of Nearburg Producing Company for an unorthodox oil well location for the Strawn formation is hereby approved for a well to be located at a point 1665 feet from the North line and 830 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Undesignated South Humble City-Strawn Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(2) The E/2 NE/4 of said Section 12 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.

(3) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
