Dear Mr. Davidson:

Reference is made to Marathon's application to amend Division Order No. 8282 to include the SW\(\frac{1}{2}SE\(\frac{1}{2}\) of Section 14, T-16-S, R-38-E, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico in order to form a standard 80 acre proration unit (the Sissi of Section 14) for the Benson #1 well. Attached for your information please find a copy of Division Order No. R-8282-B issued on September 18, 1987 wherein the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division denied Marathon's application for an amendment of Division Order No. R-8282.

In light of the above, and in an attempt to reach a mutually acceptable resolution of our differences regarding this matter, Marathon proposes the following:

- You contribute your 38.125% working interest in the SWLSEL of Section 14, T-16-S, R-38-E, to the 80 acre spacing unit and participate in the Benson #1 with a 19.0625% working interest in the 80 acre unit. This would result in an advance payment of approximately \$219,400 based on current booked well cost of \$1,151,100. Your 38.125% working interest in the SELSEL of Section 14 would remain subject to NMOCD Order No. Actual Costs of well R-8282.
- In order to help you decide whether to participate, Marathon will provide production data from the Benson No. 1 for your review.

If this offer is acceptable, or if you wish to discuss this matter further, please contact me so that we may proceed accordingly.
