Gentlemen:

This will confirm your September 30th telephone conversation with Paul Kautz and Evelyn Downs of this office concerning the above-referenced well.

According to New Mexico nomenclature the Yeso Group is broken down into separate formations. So it appears from your sundry notice that your well is perforated in the Blinebry, Tubb, Drinkard and Abo formations. Mr. Kautz has picked the tops from your log as follows: Tubb 6518, Drinkard 6836 and Abo 7080 feet.

The well cannot be produced from all zones without approval to downhole commingle or a multiple completion. It appears your production might qualify for downhole commingle. If you choose to go this route, your application to downhole commingle should be filed according to Rule 303 C of our Rules and Regs.

Since the well is currently carried as a Blinebry completion, when your downhole commingle authority is granted, you will need to submit completions for the other zones.
