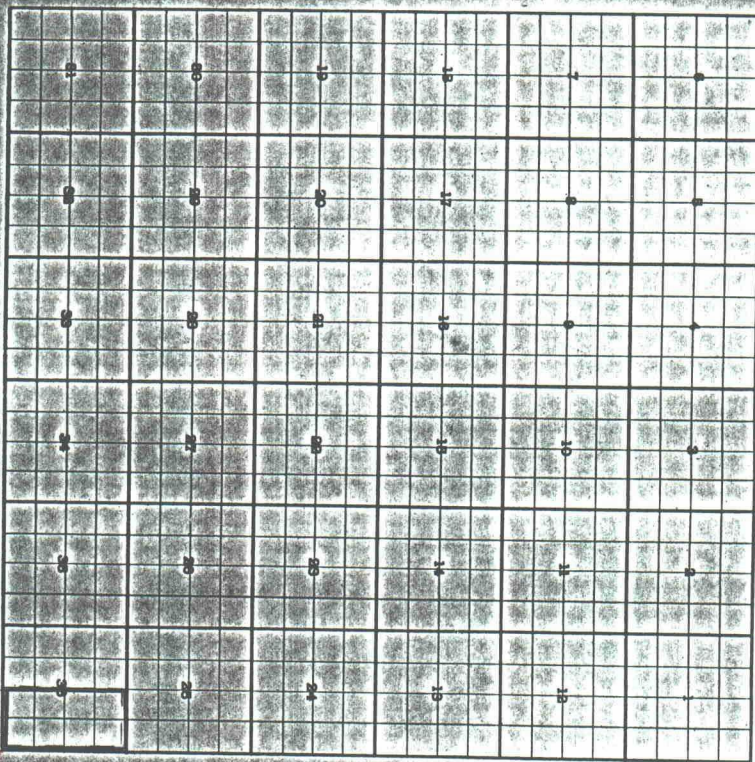

County Lea POOL Quail Ridge - Morrow GAS

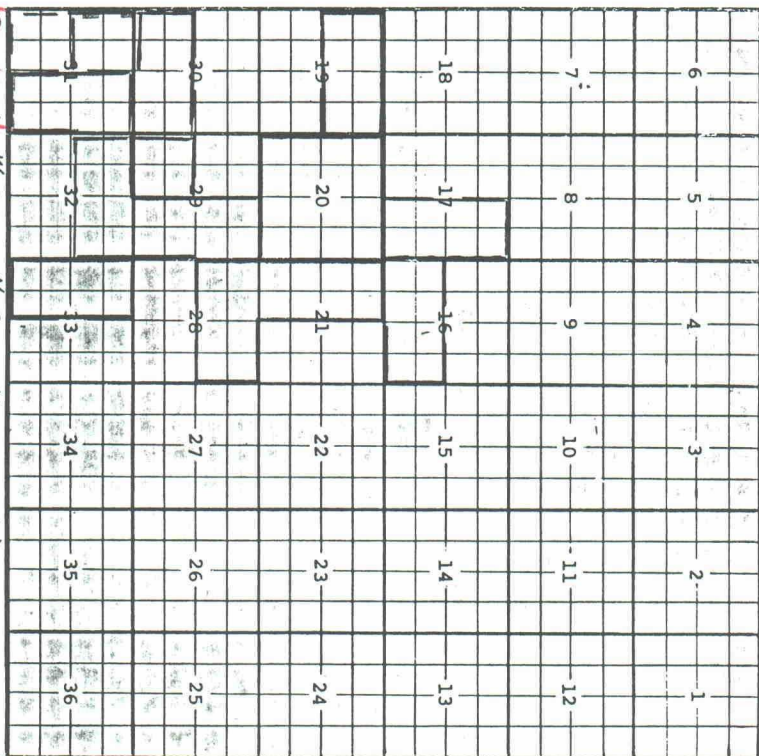
TOWNSHIP 19 South, RANGE 33 East, NEW MEXICO PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

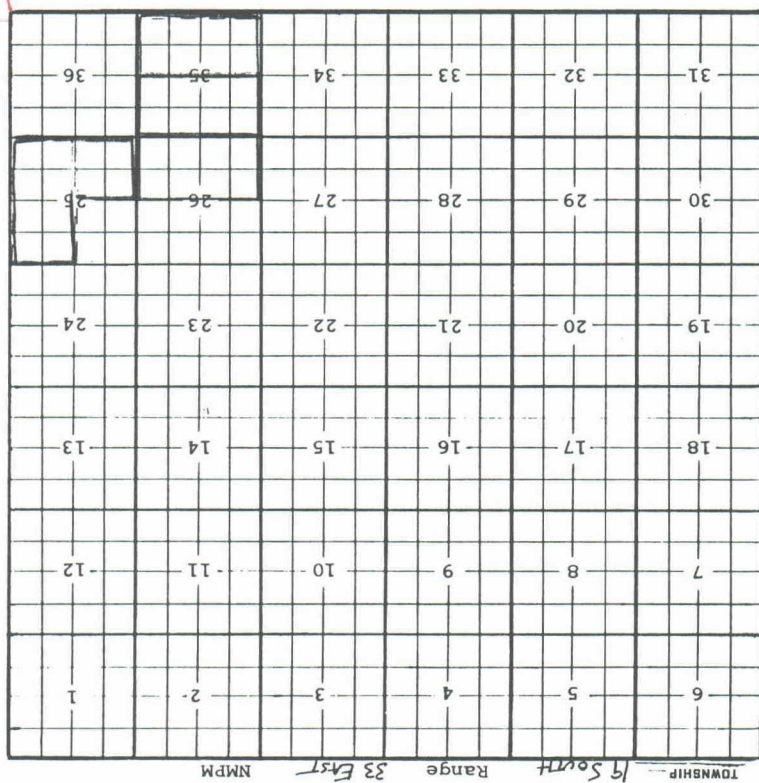

Pool East GEM - Morrow Gas



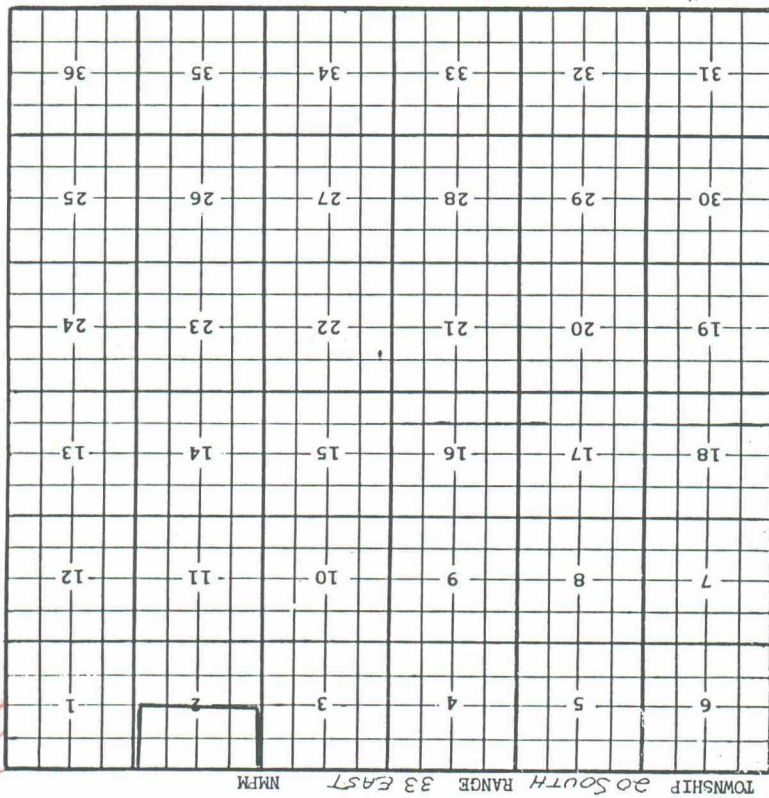

2. Upon information and belief, applicant has not made a good faith effort to obtain Grace Petroleum Corporation's joinder in the well.

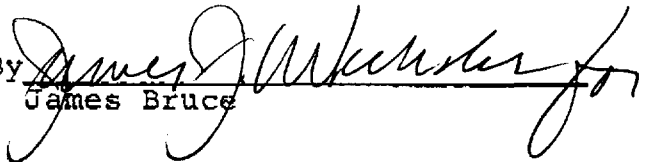
3. Grace Petroleum Corporation owns the major interest in the well and needs additional time to discuss with applicant who should operate the well.

WHEREFORE, Grace Petroleum Corporation moves that the hearing on the above case, currently set for July 26,

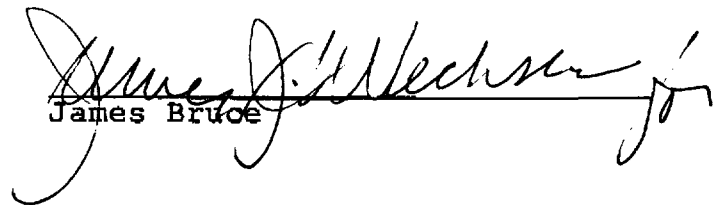
1989 be continued to the August 23, 1989 hearing, or in the alternative the August 9, 1989 examiner hearing.

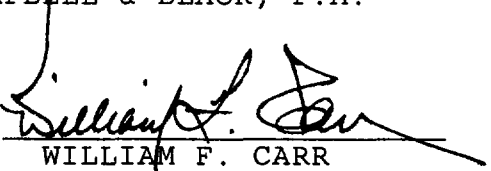
